

The process below is for students and faculty to learn how to run a "What-If" analysis.

- 1. Students who are considering changing programs can enter the new program and it will show the additional courses required if the program is chosen. This allows students to determine if a change of program is the best option.
- 2. Students are admitted under the catalog in effect at the time they begin enrollment. Program requirements can (and do) change from one catalog to another. Students can run a "What-If" analysis by choosing different catalogs.
 - a. Students can only choose a more recent catalog, or a catalog under which they attended.



Select program interested in from window that comes up. Note that the window includes all active academic programs, both Undergraduate & Graduate Academic Program will appear on the list.



A potential new catalog year can also be chosen in the Select catalog year drop down. To see a potential new catalog year, select the current academic program and choose the alternate catalog year.
